Section 1 : Organization

Souvenir Patrick Metz

The « Souvenir Patrick METZ » is managed by VCU SCHWENHEIM association under Fédération Française de Cyclisme regulation. The competition will take place 2024, April 20 & 21

Section 2 : Participation

This stage race is classified as National Elite (2.12.1). Participation is determined by F.F.C. regulations. (Art. 2.1.005). The teams will be made up of 7 runners and 3 guides.

Saturday evening dinner and Sunday morning sports breakfast will be provided by the organization.

For this event, by invitation, applications must be sent, on the form provided by the organization, before March 1, 2024, accompanied by a deposit of €450 payable to VCU Schwenheim. Deposit checks will be returned 8 days after the event, any incomplete or absent team will not have the deposit check returned.

Entries for the selected French teams will be made via web cycle.

Entries for selected foreign teams will be made by specific entry form, which will be sent to all selected teams, and must be returned with payment of entry fees (€15 x 2 x 7 or €210), before on April 13, 2024.

A route book, including all the details of the race and detailed information on the stages and timing, will be available on the website www.vcuschwenheim.fr no later than January 7, 2024.

Section 3 : Licence checking and sport director

They will take place at the starting point of the first stage, Salle des Fêtes, 178 Rue Principale in SCHWENHEIM.

The verification will take place at the office from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. on Saturday April 20, 2024.

Section 4 : Team presentation and entries signature

It will take place on the podium at the starting site according to the order communicated during the meeting..

Section 5 : Race and classification

The race includes 1 prologue and 1 stage: Time Trial prologue on Saturday, starting order (to be communicated by email 7 days before start to the team with its entry list departure from minute to minute, distance to cover 1 lap of 6km.

First stage on Sunday in line with finish circuit (3 laps of 15 km).

This event takes place according to the regulations for stage race of the F.F.C.

General Individual Classification in Yellow Jersey Time: Transport Patrick METZ

According to FFC regulations with bonus at the finish line and during the stage on the "Souvenir Patrick Metz" sprints on Sunday (no bonus during the prologue):

3 intermediate bonus sprints per stage awarding 3-2-and-a-second on each intermediate sprint and 10-6-4 seconds awarded for the first three of the stage.

Classification of Intermediate Sprints: 3 sprints per stage, according to the following scales: 4 – 2 – and 1 points. The rider with the greatest number of points is declared winner. In the event of a tie, the greatest number of 1st places will be taken into account and finally the best place in the last intermediate sprint.

Mountain classification : 4 sprints according to the following scale on GPM Sprints: 4- 2 - and 1 point. The rider with the greatest number of points is declared the winner. In the event of a tie, the greatest number of 1st places will be taken into account and finally the best place in the last sprint classification of stage 1.

The locations of all sprints will be indicated on the road book.

Ranking of the "Meilleur Alsacien" : The rider licensed in Alsace being the best ranked.

Section 6 : Anti-doping control

According to FFC regulations, location will be indicated in the road book.



Section 7 : Protocol & Jerseys

The ranking leaders must be to the protocol podium within 10 minutes of their arrival. The jerseys are given to the leaders of the rankings or to the wearer in the event of accumulation of jerseys. Leaders will be called according to the order of the protocol below. Prologue According to the prologue ranking Wearer of the 1st Alsatian jersey (best Alsatian) Wearer of the Climber Jersey (3rd in the prologue) Wearer of the Sprinter jersey (2nd in the prologue) Leader of the Yellow Jersey for the General Classification on time 1st step The first 3 of the stage Leader of Intermediate Sprints Leader in the GPM ranking The first Alsatian in general Leader, second and third in the General Classification on time Order of jerseys in case of accumulation during the different classifications : a) Yellow jersey (general classification by time) b) Sprinter jersey (general points classification)

- c) Climber jersey (GPM leader)
- d) 1st Alsatian jersey (Alsatian leader in the General Ranking)

Article 8 : Prize money based on FFC regulation

Stage 1 CLM: prize money - 610/20 Stage 2: prize money - 1220/20 grid General Individual Time Classification: prize money - 915/20 Ranking of Intermediate Sprints: Ranking of Climbing Sprints: Prizes in kind General ranking of the best Alsatian: Prize in kind

The rider with the greatest number of points is declared the winner. In the event of draw, the greatest number of 1st places will be taken into account and finally the best place in the last sprint classification of stage 1.

The locations of all sprints will be indicated on the Route Book.

Ranking of the 1st Alsatian: The rider licensed in Alsace being the best ranked.



Article 9 : Transpondeurs

Article 10 : Radio Tour

Le service d'assistance technique neutre sera assuré par Vitta. Le service est assuré au moyen de 1 voiture technique.

Article 12 : Délai d'élimination

Il est accordé un délai d'arrivée établi sur le temps du vainqueur de 12% pour l'étape en ligne. Tous coureurs étant à plus de 10 minutes du peloton sera mis hors course pour des raisons de sécurité.

Toute situation d'exception peut être tranchée par le collège des commissaires après consultation de la direction d'organisation.

Article 13 : Règle de 3 derniers kilomètres

La règle des 3 derniers kilomètres s'appliquera pour la 1ère étape selon l'article 2.6.24 de la réglementation.
